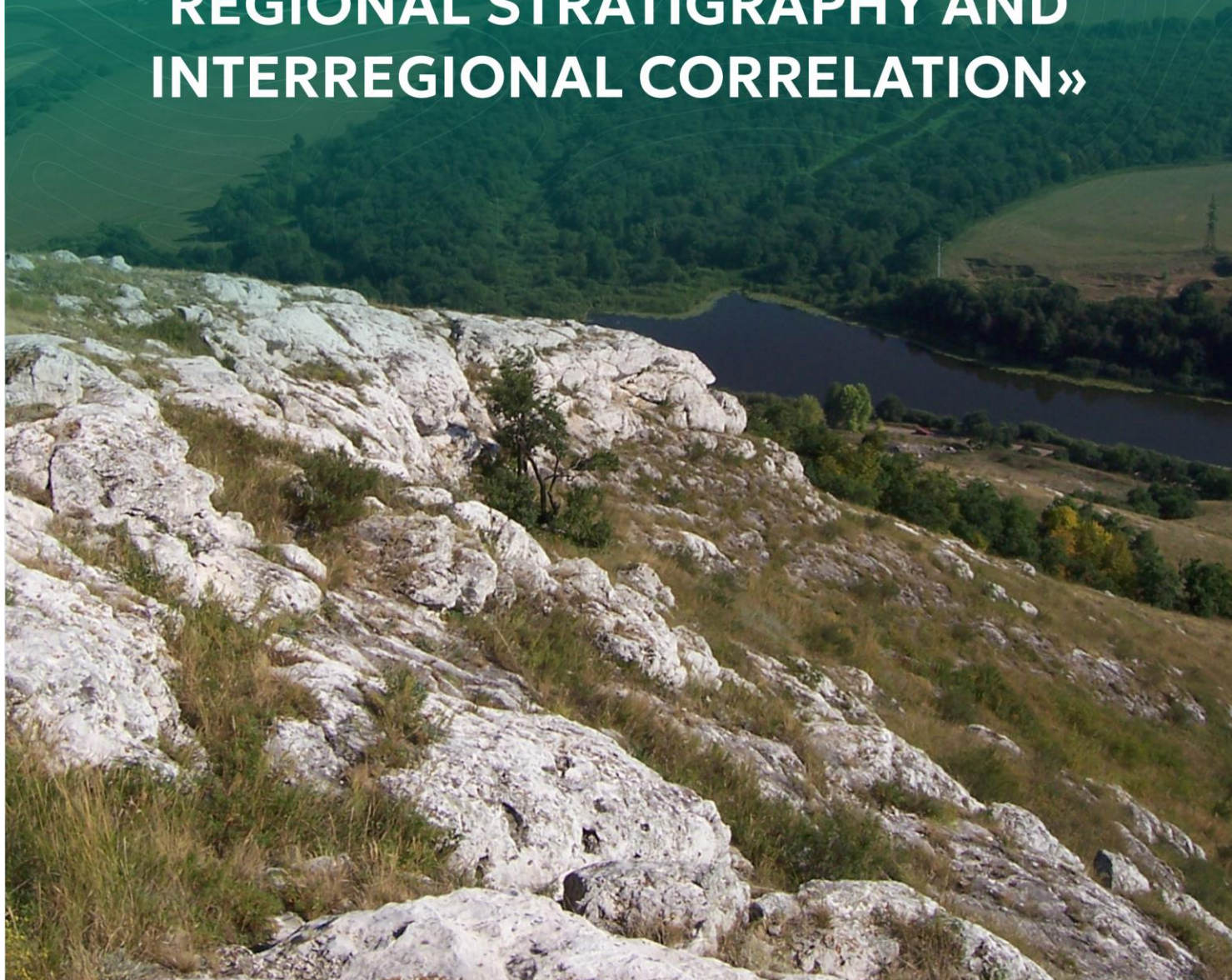

INFORMATION LETTER NO. 1

Dear colleagues,

We invite you to take part in the All-Russian meeting with international participation ‘**Paleozoic of Russia: problems of regional stratigraphy and interregional correlation**’, which will be held on **11-14 November** at the All-Russian Geological Research Institute of A.P. Karpinsky (St. Petersburg, Sredny Prospect, 74).

Since the III All-Russian Meeting ‘Paleozoic of Russia: Regional Stratigraphy, Paleontology, Geo- and Bioevents’ (St. Petersburg, 2012), a large amount of factual material on the Paleozoic stratigraphy has been accumulated, modern approaches and methods of studying sediments have been expanded and developed, which are in demand in the practice of geological works of different directions and specialization. At the same time, problematic issues related to the need to modernize the General Stratigraphic Scale, to update regional stratigraphic schemes and to refine the correlation of the Paleozoic sediments of Russia have emerged.

The aim of the forthcoming meeting is to unite the existing specialists, to consider the current problems and the latest research results, as well as to organize systematic work on the creation of modern stratigraphic schemes of the Paleozoic.

The main objective of the meeting is a broad discussion of the data obtained in recent years on geology, isotope geochronology, geochemistry, lithology, paleontology and biostratigraphy of the Paleozoic of Russia and neighboring countries, the use and synthesis of which will allow us to approach the updating of stratigraphic schemes and substantiation at a new level of interregional correlation.

The number of poster presentations for participants is not limited. The Programme Committee reserves the right to reject a paper that does not meet the theme of the meeting.

Within the framework of the meeting, in addition to plenary and sectional reports, joint meetings of the Regional Stratigraphic Commissions (RSC) and the commissions on the Paleozoic systems of the ISC are expected to be held.

There is an organizational fee for participation in the meeting; the planned amount is 3000 rubles. It is planned to prepare a collection of abstracts of the meeting by the beginning of the meeting. Abstracts in Russian or English will be accepted in a maximum of 2 A4 pages with single spacing. The rules of the abstract formatting will be communicated in the second information letter.
